PE Kits

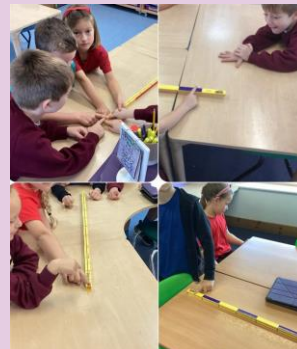
