SeeSaw Usage


Over the last few weeks, staff have been reviewing the way we use Seesaw to communicate with parents about the learning happening in school. It is a wonderful platform for you to be able to see work, read about what's happening in class and have reminders from teachers. It has been lovely to see so much parental engagement, thank you.

I am however, aware that for many parents the number of notifications can feel overwhelming. I am also aware that some parents are using the platform inappropriately and staff have needed to delete comments. Like with all new systems, there will be things along the way that need adjusting, this is one of those times.

So, to help with these issues we have decided to turn off the function which allows parents to comment and ask questions/chat with teachers online. We have also turned off the 'like' function for parents as some children were feeling pressure from this. Please continue to look at the work and talk to your child about it. You can instead, give them a real life 'like' (praise) at home.

Parents, please continue to communicate with school in the usual ways; emailing the school office with any questions; speaking to the adult on the door in the morning; speaking to the teacher at the end of the day; arranging a meeting; checking the website; reading the newsletter.
