The PTA are excited to announce the date of this year's Summer Fete - **Friday 27th June 2025, 3.15pm - 5.30pm.**

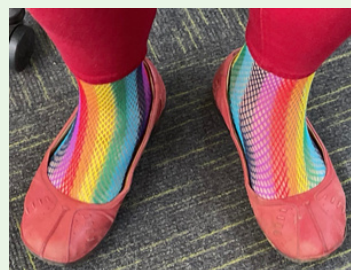
