Our aim is to allow all children to be water confident and to swim 25m using a variety of different strokes by the end of their time with us. We have always swam from Years 3 to 6, with each year group attending lessons for half a term each. The school funds these sessions as swimming is part of the PE curriculum, and we ask for contributions towards the cost of the coach. However we are extremely short with these contributions across this academic year. As a school we cannot afford to pay for the shortfall in this. Therefore it is very unlikely that we will be able to offer swimming in the same way going forward from next year.

## Newsletter Reminders

### Considerate Parking

Last week we received an email from Darwin Manor on Jeavons Lane asking us to remind parents about considerate parking. This week we have had residents from Jeavons Lane and the surrounding roads informing us that parents of Jeavons Wood pupils have been abusive to them, as well as parking inconsiderately. This is completely unacceptable behaviour and we want to remind you again to be considerate of where you park and how you treat other people.

The entrance to Darwin Manor is frequently used for medical access, and Jeavons Lane is too narrow for parking on both sides of the road. We must always make sure there is enough space for emergency vehicles to get through.

Please use alternative parking at The Hub, Church Car Park or Cricket Pavilion and allow enough time in the mornings to park considerately and safely. Thank you.

### Cambourne Library Temporary Closure

Cambourne Library will be temporarily closed for refurbishment from **Monday 24th March** for approximately 3 months.

From Monday 31st March we will have additional hours at Comberton and Papworth Libraries, plus a mobile library will be at the Hub car park in Cambourne on Saturdays 26th April, 24th May and 28th June from 10am-4pm.
