From 8th March 2021, Jeavons Wood will begin welcoming all children in Pre-School, Reception and Years 1-6 back to school.

Our school will no longer need to provide separate childcare for key workers' children or make separate provision available for vulnerable children.

Will school be safe?



If a child or a family member has any symptoms they **MUST stay at home**.



Everyone will wash their hands on entry and regularly during the day.



Surfaces and equipment will be cleaned regularly.



Toys and equipment will be restricted if they cannot be easily cleaned.



A one-way system will be in operation for drop off and collection times.



Parents, carers and household groups **MUST** still maintain 2m distance from others.




Children will now be taught in normal sized class groups.



There will be changes to the school day such as the timing of breaks.



Classes will be kept apart as much as possible but **social distancing will NOT be possible** within those groups.



Visitors, **including parents and carers**, will **NOT** be allowed in school without a prior appointment.



Visitors into the school building have to wear a mask. It is **NOT** recommended that primary aged children wear face coverings.

What if someone gets the virus in school?

The adult or child with symptoms must self-isolate for 10 days and arrange to be tested.

The people who live with that person must also self-isolate for 10 days. Other children and adults in the same group are not expected to self-isolate unless advised to do so by Public Health England.

If anyone attending school tests positive, their WHOLE CLASS GROUP may be asked to self-isolate for 10 days. No fines will be issued for non-attendance in this instance.

When and where do I bring my child?



Parents **MUST** ensure that all children remain under close supervision

Gates will be open between 8.40am- 9.00am as usual for ALL children



Classroom doors open from 8.45am.

Foundation parents to use the car park entrance pathway.

Year 1/2 parents and children to use the main front gate.

Year 3 children with parents to use the top gate please if dropping off and collecting. Year Three children can be dropped at either gate to walk around themselves.

Year 4/5/6 children to use either gate and walk around to their area.



Children **MUST** be collected at the correct time.

Main gates to the playground will be re-opened at 3.05pm.

Foundation/Reception: 3pm (as usual) (Bumblebees will be dismissed from the pre-school door to avoid too many parents in the Foundation outside area)

Year 1/2: 3.10pm (as usual)

Year 3/4: 3.15pm (as usual)

Year 5/6: 3.15pm (as usual)



Please collect your child/children and then exit through the same gate. If you have a Yr1/2 child then this should be the front gate.

Older children can walk around and meet you there or at a pre-arranged place outside the front gate.

As the paths around the school are narrow, these are for children only.

Please use the feet marking to help socially distance while dropping off and picking up.



Parents and carers must **NOT** enter the cloakrooms or classrooms.



Drop off and collection may take longer than usual. Please be patient. Staff will be available to help direct parents and children

What are the important rules?




Children **MUST** stay at home and parents **MUST** inform the school immediately if anyone in their household is poorly.



Visitors into the school building have to wear a mask.



Everyone will wash their hands on entry and regularly during the day.



No parents or carers may enter the building without an appointment.



Parents, carers and household groups **MUST** still maintain 2m distance from others.



Toys and equipment **MUST** not be brought into school.



Children **MUST** arrive punctually and be collected at the correct time.



Childminders, friends and other relatives can now collect and drop off at school. Children will **ONLY** be released to emergency contacts listed on a child's school file.



Full school uniform and appropriate footwear should now be worn if possible. School clothes are expected to be clean each day.

What will my child need?



Children **MUST** have a pre-booked school meal or bring a healthy named packed lunch instead.



All children **MUST** bring a named bottle filled with water.



A piece of fruit or vegetable for their mid-morning snack KS2(KS1 fruit & veg scheme in place)



A named sunhat to keep them protected while outside in hot weather.



In hot weather, suitable long-lasting sun cream to be applied before school for all children.



Clean, named school uniform and PE kit is now expected. No heeled shoes and no denim should be worn. Jewellery is not permitted.



Any reading books or ipads still at home should now be returned to school.



No pens, pencils, toys or other items should be brought from home.
