Learn how to tap, double-tap and tap and drag using the cursor on an iPad.

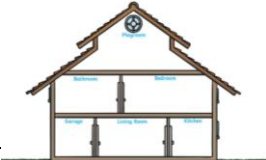
Learn how to save work and type on an iPad.

Network	A group of computers that are connected.
