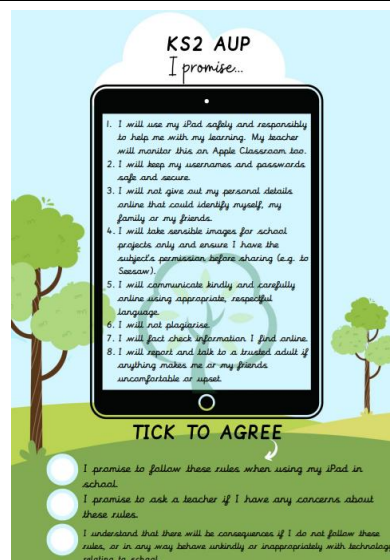


Knowledge Organiser for Year 6

Digital literacy	Being confident, creative, and safe when using technology for learning and communication.
AUP (Acceptable Use Policy)	A set of rules that explain how to use devices and the internet responsibly.
Pages	An app for writing and creating documents on an iPad.
Keynote	An app for making presentations with text, images, and animations.
Numbers	An app for creating spreadsheets and charts.
iMovie	An app for editing videos and adding effects.
Garage Band	An app for creating and editing instruments (including voice) and soundtracks.
